

CAPE BRETON BIKE RALLY

CONTRACT OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS POLICY 2016

1. (MEMBERSHIP VENDORS) the Cape Breton Bike Rally 2016, has reserved space(s) for returning Vendors from the Cape Bike Rally 2015.
2. (NON MEMBERS) please confirm space(s) with the Vendor Committee as space(s) are limited
3. Space(s) are due in full by June 30th 2016. All space(s) will be directed by the Cape Breton Bike Rally.
4. Vendors and Food Vendors agree to conform to the Nova Scotia Fire Marshalls Code.
5. Prior to set up all Vendors shall check-in with the Cape Breton Bike Rally Vendor Committee and will receive a copy of the Vendor Village for their location.
6. Each Vendor shall insure their own merchandise against fire, theft and all perils. Proof of insurance is required or contact us for the 2016 Waiver.
7. The Cape Breton Bike Rally or any event Sponsor(s) are not responsible for any loss incurred by any Vendor.
8. All Vendors are responsible for keeping their site clean. All garbage is to be bagged and ready for pick up at the end of each night.
9. Set up is Friday July 29th, 2016, 6:00am.
10. Vendors are to supply their own outdoor circuit breaker electrical cord.
11. All belongings to the Vendor must be kept within the confines of the rented space dimensions. Nothing belonging to a Vendor shall block the visibility of another Vendor. Any damage, to the building, to the site or supplier's equipment caused by a Vendor, will be the responsibility of the vendor.
12. Space(s) is to be used for products and purpose of the Vendor and cannot be sublet or used by other than the Vendor without written consent of the Cape Breton Bike Rally.
13. Insure your booth(s) tent(s) trailer(s) are secure.
14. CANCELLATION: No Space(s) will be held until space(s) are paid in full. Any Vendor who does not arrive or cancels without notification will not be refunded any monies paid.
15. In the unlikely event of the Cape Breton Bike Rally 2016 having to canceling the event due to any unforeseen circumstances, the Cape Breton Bike Rally 2016 will refund all monies paid within 6-8 weeks after the show date. The Cape Breton Bike Rally 2016 shall not be liable for any cost incurred by the Vendor as a result of such cancellation.
16. No alcohol on site.
17. All applicable taxes at time of the event are the sole responsibility of the Vendor.
18. Vehicle Restrictions: Vehicles on-site or for display, within their space(s), must first apply for approval from the Cape Breton Bike Rally, vehicle parking for Vendors will supplied.
19. No tickets of any kind are able to be sold unless you are a non profit or permission is granted by the Cape Breton Bike Rally.
20. Proper proof of Club affiliation with a non profit organization must be shown prior to the event by June 30th 2016.

21. It is the responsibility of the Food Vendor to acquire proper documents for sampling food.
22. The Cape Breton Bike Rally logo is the property of the Cape Breton Bike Rally and is not to be used without written permission from the Cape Breton Bike Rally.
23. Each Vendor is responsible for transfer of materials of their allotted space(s).
24. All Vendors must conform to the Nova Scotia Health and Safety Act.
25. No removal, moving or dismantling of the Vendor before the Vendor checks in with the Vendor Committee before departure.
